

SHORT & LONG DOGS

YOU'LL NEED: CONSTRUCTION PAPER, SCISSORS,
DOG TEMPLATE (OPTIONAL), TAPE

SHORT and **LONG** are **OPPOSITES!** This paper dog helps show us the difference between short and long!

- **DRAW** a dog from the side. Make sure you draw the back legs, tail, belly, neck, front paws, head, face, and ears! Cut out the dog.
- **CUT** a line down the middle of the dog, right where the belly would be.
- **FOLD** a long strip of paper (cut it to be as wide as your dog's belly). To do an **ACCORDION** fold, press the end over, then flip the whole strip and fold the end over the other way (about 1 inch at a time). When you're done, the paper will squish up small and stretch out long!
- **TAPE** the long strip to the back of your tail end, then the other side of the strip to the face end. Now watch your doggie stretch and squish!
