## **SHORT & LONG DOGS**

YOU'LL NEED: CONSTRUCTION PAPER, SCISSORS, DOG TEMPLATE (OPTIONAL), TAPE

## SHORT and LONG are OPPOSITES! This paper dog helps show us the difference between short and long!

- **DRAW** a dog from the side. Make sure you draw the back legs, tail, belly, neck, front paws, head, face, and ears! Cut out the dog.
- CUT a line down the middle of the dog, right where the belly would be.
- FOLD a long strip of paper (cut it to be as wide as your dog's belly). To do an ACCORDION fold, press the end over, then flip the whole strip and fold the end over the other way (about 1 inch at a time). When you're done, the paper will squish up small and stretch out long!
- TAPE the long strip to the back of your tail end, then the other side of the strip to the face end. Now watch your doggie stretch and squish!
