YARN WEAVING BERRIES

YOU'LL NEED: CARDSTOCK, HOLE PUNCH, YARN, SCISSORS, TAPE

- Draw or print a berry on a piece of thick paper. CUT out the berry shape.
- Have a grownup help you make small holes around the edges of the berry with a hole punch or scissors.
- Now you're ready to practice SEWING! This is an excellent FINE MOTOR activity. To weave, thread one end of a piece of yarn through one of the holes, then tape it to the back.
- Grab the un-taped end of the yarn, and now weave that through another hole in the berry. Continue like this until you sew around the entire fruit! You can also undo the threading to play again and again.
- HINT! You might want to wrap the end of the yarn in a small piece of tape to help it slide through the holes more easily.
