The Children's Librarian position is now open as Diana is retiring August 5th. The Public Services Assistant position is being posted soon. HVAC project starts Monday 4/15; weather permitting – should be done around the end of April, the project is weather dependent. Larson represented the library and the Summer Reading program at What's Cooking event where we promoted the space-themed summer reading program, over 150 people interacted.

- d. WPL Friends Foundation Report: April book drive upcoming, trivia event brought 86 people and raised \$1400. The team has requested new teen area furniture, banners, iPads and TVs for children's department.
- e. Ways and Means Committee: Did not meet.
- f. Strategic Plan Update: Keri applied for a STEM grant and was approved – more details to come. Local history program on Granger Homesteads this Sunday, Amish program had about 35 people, knitting program was full. Overall great program attendance.
