Paper Plate Donuts: 3 ways!

YOU'LL NEED: PAPER PLATES, SCISSORS, MARKERS, CRAYONS OR PAINT, GLUE OR TAPE, & SCRAP PAPER OR STICKERS

1. DONUTS + SPRINKLE COUNTING

To make each donut, cut out the center of a paper plate (use the ridges to guide you). To frost your donut, draw the donut hole onto a piece of paper, and cut a frosting shape around it. Cut out that center circle, and then glue or tape your frosting onto your donut!

Decorate your dream donut however you'd like! For counting practice, roll a pair of dice and add that many sprinkles to each donut.





3. DONUT GARLAND

Punch or cut two holes a few inches apart at the top of each donut, and thread them onto a string. Hang your cheerful donut garland and enjoy. Donut worry, be happy!



2. DONUT RING TOSS

Once your donuts are ready for action, find a water bottle or similar shaped item, and try to toss your donuts onto the target! How many can you get? What happens if you step further back?

You can also try using your donut like a frisbee- try to sail it into a basket or box! How far away can you stand?
