Butterfly Rings

YOU'LL NEED: PAPER, MARKERS OR CRAYONS, GLUE,
PIPECLEANERS, GOOGLE EYES

1. CUT OUT

- Cut out a butterfly. Draw your own, or use the template on this page. We used patterned paper, but you could also color your own in any design that you like!
- Cut a strip of paper about an inch wide, that's long enough to wrap around your finger, plus a little extra.





2. DECORATE

- Bring your butterfly to life by adding some eyes, a belly, or some designs on the wings. To make antennae, cut two 2-inch pieces of pipe cleaner and tape them to the inside of the ring.
- Fold the wings up around the belly to give your butterfly a 3D look.

3. ASSEMBLE

- To make the ring, wrap the strip of paper loosely around your finger and make a small mark where the paper meets. Glue or tape the paper in a ring shape to the size that you measured. Glue the butterfly to the top of the ring. Your butterfly would make a great puppet- what stories can you imagine?

Did you know...?

- A group of butterflies is called a **KALEIDOSCOPE!**
