

# Frog Puppet

YOU'LL NEED: PAPER PLATE, CONSTRUCTION PAPER, PAINT OR MARKERS, SCISSORS, GLUE, EGG CARTON, STAPLER OR TAPE

## 1. CUT & PAINT

- **TRACE** your paper plate onto construction paper, and cut out the circle.
- **PAINT** the bottom side of the plate in your favorite froggy colors and patterns.
- **CUT** the paper plate in half.
- To make eyes, **CUT** two cups from an egg carton, and paint them to match your frog. You can finish by adding googly eyes or drawing on the egg cup eyes.



## 2. ASSEMBLE

- Use **GLUE** or **STAPLES** to attach your frog's eyes to the painted side of one plate. Make sure your frog is looking outwards toward the rounded side!
- Carefully apply **GLUE** around the edge of the construction paper circle.
- Line up the paper plate so it matches the paper circle, and carefully stick it to the glue, paint-side-up. **LET DRY.**

## 3. PLAY!

- To make your frog into a puppet, carefully fold the two plates down in the middle, making a pocket for your hand!
- If you'd like to add a froggy tongue, **CUT** a long strip of paper. **ROLL** it tightly around a pencil to make a curl, and tape it inside the froggy mouth.
- Your frog puppet is ready! **RIBBIT!!!!**
