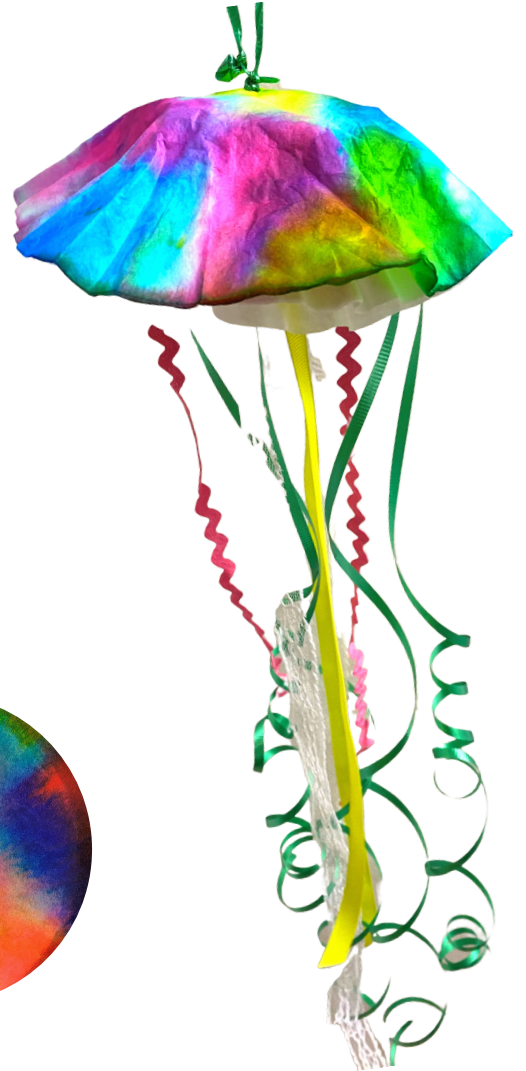


Jellyfish!

YOU'LL NEED: COFFEE FILTERS OR TISSUE PAPER, FOOD COLORING OR MARKERS, RIBBON, TAPE

1. COLOR

- Jellyfish come in all the colors of the rainbow, and some even glow! To make your jellyfish body, stack two or three coffee filters together and lay them out flat.
- Use markers to color the filter, or add a few drops of food coloring around the filter in a dot pattern.
- Carefully add a few drops of water and watch what happens to the colors! Try making several jellyfish, and using different water techniques: an eyedropper, a spray bottle, or float the filter on a bowl of water. What do you notice? Let them dry.



2. ASSEMBLE

- You may want to add more plain coffee filters underneath to help your jelly hold its shape- line them all up flat. Punch or cut a small hole in the very middle of the coffee filters.
- Cut a long length of ribbon or string, and thread your jellyfish layers onto it. Tie a big knot under the last one to keep them from sliding down, and tie a knot with a loop at the top, so you can hang your jellyfish up!
- Now you can add your jellyfish tentacles! Use any dangly material you can find, and tape them underneath your jelly's body. Try to keep them balanced, so your jellyfish can swim straight!
