

# Newspaper Shark!

YOU'LL NEED: CONSTRUCTION PAPER, NEWSPAPER, SCISSORS, GLUE, GOOGLE EYES (OPTIONAL)

## 1. MAKE YOUR BASE

- Use a piece of blue construction paper or cardstock for your base. For this project, we're going to **LAYER** different shapes to make a shark.
- **CUT** the body of your shark out of newspaper. A lot of sharks have rounded snouts, but there are lots of different species- the shape is up to you!



## 2. CUT OUT SHAPES

- Cut the rest of your shapes! You'll need:
  - a darker blue **STRIP** or two for water (what type of lines remind you of water? Is your water going to be **CHOPPY** or **STILL**? You can use different colors to make lots of waves if you'd like!)
  - a black half-circle for a mouth
  - **TRIANGLES** for teeth (how many teeth will your shark have? Are they big or little?)
  - Circles for eyes (you can use google eyes if you have them, or draw your own.)

## 3. ASSEMBLE

- **GLUE** down your pieces in the order you want them. The **FIRST** things you glue down will be at the **BACK** of your picture- the last ones you glue down will be in the **FRONT**.
- You can decide what expression your shark will have.

*Did you know...?*

- A group of sharks is called a **SHIVER!**
