Cinnamon Applesauce Ornaments!

YOU'LL NEED: APPLESAUCE, CINNAMON, COOKIE CUTTERS, SPOON, WAX PAPER

1. MIX

- In a bowl, mix together **EQUAL PARTS** applesauce and cinnamon. Try using 1 cup of each, or, if you have single-serve packs of applesauce, you can use the empty container to measure your cinnamon.

- Stir the mix together until it turns brown and starts to feel like play-dough. Then take it out and knead it a little bit with your hands til it forms into a ball.



2. ROLL & CUT

Lay out a piece of wax paper, and dust it with a little bit of cinnamon to prevent your mixture sticking. Use a roller or your hands to flatten it out, to about 1/4 inch thick. The thicker your dough, the longer it will take to dry.
Use cookie cutters to punch out a shape for your ornament. You can also make your own shape. Use a pencil to punch a hole somewhere near the top of your ornament, so you can attach a hanger. You can re-roll the extra dough and make more ornaments.

- While your dough is still wet, you can experiment with adding texture to your ornament. Try using the tines of a fork to make a pattern.

3. DRY & HANG

- Leave your ornaments on a piece of wax paper to dry for at least 2 days. You might want to turn them over a few times so that they dry evenly.

- Once they're completely dry, you can add a loop of yarn, string, or ribbon to hang your ornament!



Caution: do not eat this dough! Even though the ingredients are edible, they will give you a stomachache on their own!
