



Pre-K Activity Pack: Colors!

Tissue Paper Stained Glass

Materials:

- 2 contact paper squares
- Scissors
- Construction paper
- Tissue paper bits

1. Decide on the shape you want to make your stained glass. Draw the shape on a piece of construction paper, small enough that it will fit inside of your contact paper.
2. Have a grown up help you cut out the **INSIDE** of your shape. You're creating a **FRAME** for your "stained glass."
3. Peel the backing off of one piece of contact paper and lay it sticky side up. Carefully press your frame onto the sticky surface. If you don't have contact paper, you can also line up rows of clear tape.
4. Fill the inside of your frame with small pieces of tissue paper! You can decide how you want it to look- do you want to use all the colors, or stick to **WARM** colors, or **COOL** colors? Do you want to use large pieces, or small pieces?
5. Fill up the whole frame. You can **LAYER** pieces of tissue paper. How do the colors change when you have more than one piece? When you are finished, peel the back off the other piece of contact paper, and very carefully lay it on top, to keep your tissue paper in place. Trim around the edges of your frame if you want.
6. Hang or hold your art in front of a sunny window. Do you see light reflecting the colors you used?
