

# Salt + Watercolor Snowflakes!

YOU'LL NEED: CONSTRUCTION OR WATERCOLOR PAPER, WATERCOLOR PAINTS, WHITE CRAYON, TABLE SALT



## 1. DRAW SNOWFLAKES

- **CUT** your paper to the size you want.
- Then **DRAW** a snowflake scene onto the paper in white crayon. If you want, you can make a bunch of paintings to give away or send in the mail.

## 2. PAINT

- Prepare your watercolors by mixing up a color that you like. **BRUSH** some water on top of your drawing, and then add your **PAINT** to the top. The wax crayon will **RESIST** the wet paint, so the your snowflakes will magically appear as color fills in around them!
- You can **BLEND** colors however you like- adding more water will make the colors lighter, and adding more paint will make the colors brighter.

## 3. SALT

- Before your paintings are dry, **SPRINKLE** a pinch of table salt over the top. The salt will **ABSORB** the water, making a pretty sunburst shape. Be careful not to use too much salt, this works best with just a few crystals here and there.
- Once your paintings are dry, carefully brush off the salt. Your beautiful, wintery paintings are ready to enjoy!
